We asked Louise and Steven how they felt when they walked into their new home for the first time?

We were really excited about seeing our house finished for the first time. We made our trip from the UK as soon as the house was completed at the end of November 2008. We arrived late evening and were met personally by George, the developer, at the entrance to Rabaska. When he took us to the property we got the impression he was really excited and proud to handover the house. So he should of too, as when we walked in the door it looked amazing, better than we could have ever expected. It had a warm and real homely feel.
